

# FEBRUARY CDE NEWSLETTER

All the technical aspects of the CDE website have been finished and now the **PR-team** is in the final stages of finishing it. The website should be up in no time! The **Leisure Team** has gathered all the work from the art and writing competitions to be judged. The winners will be announced in 2-3 weeks. Planning of other events is on the way, with the rotation system in mind. An event is being planned together with the Pride club, to take place after the Easter holidays.

The **Improvement Team** is working on smaller proposals related to hygiene and have bought playing cards for the preau.

The **Mini CDE** have been able to continue holding meetings throughout the new rotation system. They have received a lot of feedback and constructive criticism from the younger years and are working on the issues.

The **Amnesty** candles and chocolates sales were successfully organised. The chocolate heart sales managed to raise 200 euros for Amnesty International. The last remaining candles are being sold to teachers and Easter sales will start soon.

Over the course of the last month, the **Grand Debate Team** have established the different teams for each year group. Applications have now come to a close, with mentoring having started. The team is now dealing with the logistical challenges surrounding the Grand Debates and expects to be on track to begin the debates in late-April.

The distribution of **jumpers** have started and will continue until March 19th. Unfortunately, the baby blue jumpers will arrive later, due to a lack of stock. An email will be sent to parents with additional information.

The process of ordering well-being kits with art supplies and other stress relieving materials has finished and will be available in all the preaus soon. The students have requested improved school agendas, so redesigns for the agendas are being discussed. Meetings with the school psychologists are being held to try to improve the communication between students and psychologists. A lot of relevant topics were discussed during the Council of the 14 Presidencies, which was attended by our President on the 21st of February. Notable is the E-Sports tournament, which is being organised by CoSup, as well as the experience of the exams, which in most schools went as smoothly as could be expected during times like these. We are also proud to say that the "Writing's on the Wall" project by the Climate Academy was presented by Mr Pye and positively received by the all the 13 Presidents, who will try to implement it in their respective schools.

Multiple representatives from the CDE attended the CEES meeting, which took place on 11th of February. The main topics brought up were the well-being of the students, S4 B-tests, bring your own device project and COVID-19 planning.

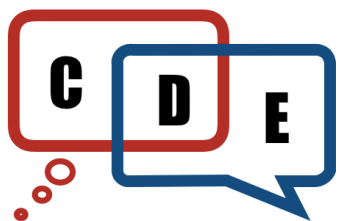
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
