2023-2024 School charges

Parents have to pay school charges per year and per child enrolled at the school. Parents belonging to the organisations mentioned below are exonerated from paying school fees, <u>BUT NOT FROM OTHER</u> CHARGES:

- Officials of the European Union Institutions (employed directly and continuously for a minimum period of one year).
- Teaching and non-teaching staff of the European schools (with a minimum contract of one year).

These fees are obligatory and non-refundable. An invoice for the school charges and, if applicable, school fees will be sent at the beginning of the school year. This will have to be paid by bank transfer within the deadline mentioned in the invoice.
