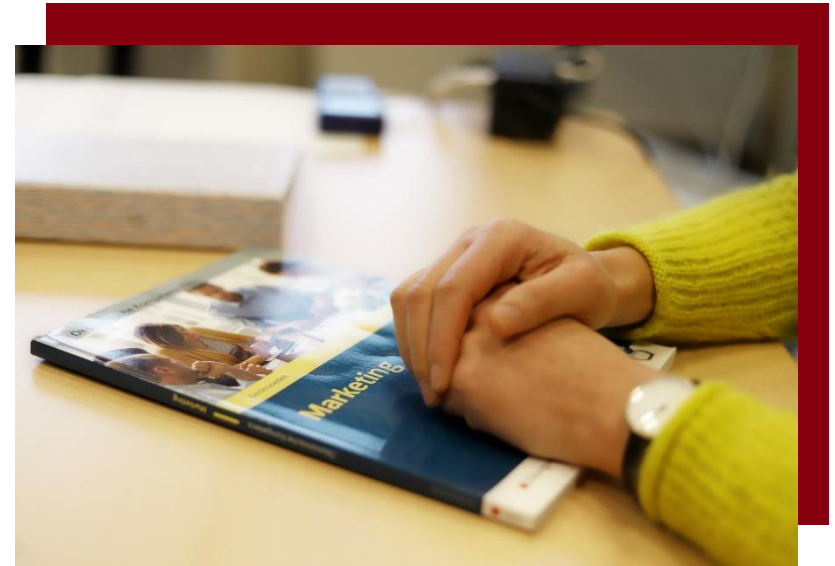


# Vocational Secondary School (Fachoberschule | FOS) at iDSB

## Vocational Secondary School (FOS) at iDSB

- after grade 10 (Secondary School)
- 2 specializations
  - Economics and Business administration
  - Social studies
- practical and specialized training
- degree after completion of 2 years: entrance qualification for a University of Applied Sciences
- entitled for academic studies
  - at Universities of Applied Sciences in Germany and
  - at various universities worldwide which offer Bachelor as well as Master studies
- further options: transition
  - to a vocational training in Germany | Europe or
  - to grade 12 at a higher vocational secondary school
- targeted vocational orientation and career counseling | student advisory service
- target group: motivated students, who are interested in a practical vocational training with the possibility to attend university afterwards



# Fachoberschule at iDSB

## Requirements

- completion | pass of grade 10 at a secondary school
- General Certificate of Secondary Education



## School subjects

- General subjects
  - German
  - English
  - Mathematics
  - Physical Education
  - Science/Politics/History
- Optional:
  - Second Foreign Language (French or Dutch)
- Vocational subjects:
  - Economics and Business administration:
    - Business Administration and Accounting
    - Economics
    - Legal Studies
    - Business Information Systems
  - Social Studies:
    - Psychology/Science of Education
    - Music or Art
    - Economics and Business Studies



# Fachoberschule at iDSB

## Optional: Digital FOS

Hybrid, location independent and innovative learning at your local school and at iDSB:

- completion of internships in grade 11 at your place of residence, in Brussels or at an operation abroad
- early application for internships (May / June)
- grade 12: hybrid classes throughout the whole school year
- recommendable: mentors at local schools to support students individually



# Fachoberschule at iDSB

## Digital FOS

- Hybrid learning: (almost exclusively virtual)
  - virtual connection to the lessons at iDSB
    - virtual classroom via highly innovative digital devices and equipment
    - participation via Microsoft Teams
    - students just need a laptop or tablet, a WIFI connection, a camera and a microphone
  - students need to be present at their local schools every day
  - students can participate in some courses on-site (e.g. Physical Education)
- Obligatory phases of attendance at iDSB in Brussels
  - kick-off week – first week in September
  - optional: final exam preparation week – end of April
  - optional: written exams – beginning of May (one week)
  - oral exams – mid June (1 bis 3 days)
  - graduation ceremony (mid/end June)



## Practical information and tips

- **Accommodation**
  - support in finding a host family or shared flat with other students or interns at iDSB
  - support in finding housing close to iDSB
- **School fees**
  - students pay their usual school fees at their home school
  - the schools discharge parts of the fees to iDSB

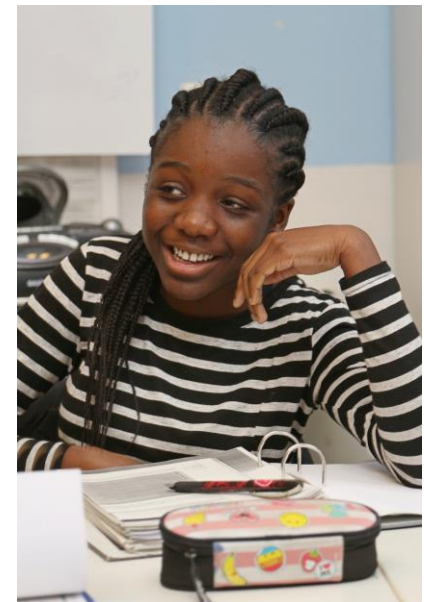


# REALschule at iDSB

Our REALschule starts with grade 5 (orientation level) and ends with the “Hauptschulabschluss” in grade 9 or in grade 10 with the “Mittlerer Bildungsabschluss”.

From grades 6 to 8, REALschulstudents learn in differentiated classes together with high school students. The students learn English. If you are interested, French can be added as a second foreign language.

The performance evaluation takes place via differentiated class work and lesson reviews, both in writing and orally.



# REALschule at iDSB

- Subject teachers decide the content based on the curricula of the region of Thüringen -Thüringer-Schul-Portal - Regelschule.
- Then REALschulstudents are prepared intensively in small groups for taking final exams of the REALschulclass 9/10.

# REALschule an der iDSB

- The intermediate level of education in the course REALschule ends with two different possibilities at the iDSB:
- Admission to the FOS ( Fachoberschule ) entrance qualification or
- Admission to the upper school level for the Abitur. (Gymnasium).
