

UCAS policy

Autumn 2014

1. An application to UCAS costs €260<sup>1</sup>. The fee is payable to the school bank account specified by the school accountant.
2. The application fee of €260 also covers a candidate's possible application to The Netherlands, to France or to any other EU country for which an application would otherwise have cost €130<sup>1</sup>.
3. An application to the UK via UCAS will only be dealt with by the school's nominated UCAS representative and against the correct payment of the sum of €260. A pupil, or an ex-pupil, is not entitled to ask any other member of the staff of eeb2 to take care of an application.
4. One application fee of €260 covers the candidate's initial application plus a possible re-application through UCAS the year following the first one.
5. Applicants to Oxford and to Cambridge can only be supported by the school if they comply fully with Oxbridge guidelines i.e. 85% minimum average predicted (or attained) at the EB with 90% predicted (or attained) in the subject closest to the proposed course of study at the university.
6. A UCAS application will normally take place during a candidate's 7<sup>th</sup> Year. Entry to a UK university, by UCAS rules, follows either in the autumn immediately following the EB, or in the autumn one year later, after a Gap Year.
7. Candidates may also apply through eeb2 during the period of maximum one academic year after taking their EB.
8. Beyond the period of one academic year after the EB, the school will no longer be able to write a valid reference. Candidates in need of a reference after the end of this period of twelve months will need to choose a referee from outside eeb2.
